Rules for Interreg 2021-2027 - timeline

- Commission proposal for regulations on Interreg and structural funds
- Negotiations with the Council and the European Parliament ongoing – progress on provisional agreements
- The German presidency aims to have regulations adopted by February 2021
- Including EC implementing regulation on list of programmes

Submission of programmes - timeline

- Programmes to be submitted up to 9 months after the regulations enter into force
- Commission sends comments within 3 months
- We encourage to continue the programming process and to finalise as much as possible even if there are still some regulatory uncertainties, in order to have a smooth formal adoption process

Rules for Interreg – negotiations –thematic concentration

- **EC proposal in May 2018:** 60% of the programme budget on maximum 3 policy objectives or Interreg Specific Objective
- **Provisional agreement between EC + Council + EP:**
 - At least 60% of allocations to max three PO's, and **one of them has to be PO2 (environment and climate)**
 - For **land borders**, both PO2 and PO4 (labour market, education, social issues) are mandatory.
- Interreg specific objective: Programmes may allocate 10% to this objective
